PROGRAM OVERVIEW & STRUCTURE

- 42 credits curriculum : 21 credits of core courses, 15 credits of concentration courses and 6 credits of practicum and related assignments.
- Applications welcomed from all backgrounds; in some circumstances, remedial or bridging courses could be required.
- Classes held during evenings and week-ends to suit the needs of working professionals
- The Program could be completed on a full time basis in a minimum of 20 months; or on a part-time basis.
- Offered at the Faculty of Health Sciences at St. Georges Health Complex in Achrafieh, Beirut.
- The Fall Semester begins on August 28, 2017.
