IV. Library and Laboratory Deposit Fee

A library and laboratory deposit fee of 170 USD is required of every student enrolling in UOB. This deposit is held until the student graduates or discontinues his course of study, at which time the deposit, minus debts incurred, will be returned.

V. National Social Security Fund (NSSF) – Medical Branch

Lebanese Law requires Lebanese students to enroll in the NSSF medical branch. The fee for the year is 30% of the legal minimum salary.

VI. Student Activities

A fee of 150 USD is charged every semester to cover student activities.

VII. Internet Fee

A fee of 30 USD is charged every semester to cover student internet services.

VIII. Graduation Fees

Graduation fees of 75 USD is charged to every graduating student upon submitting the clearance form.

IX. Method of Payment

Payment should be made in CASH at the university Cashier's Office.



X. Withdrawals

If a duly registered student withdraws for justifiable reasons, the following refund schedule will be applied:

Before the official beginning of classes	75% of tuition
During the first week of classes	50% of tuition
During the second week of classes	25% of tuition

Refunds are not made for the summer session.
