### IV. Library and Laboratory Deposit Fee

A library and laboratory deposit fee of 493,000 L.L. is required of every student enrolling in UOB. This deposit is held until the student graduates or discontinues his course of study, at which time the deposit, minus debts incurred, will be returned.

### V. National Social Security Fund (NSSF) – Medical Branch

Lebanese Law requires Lebanese students to enroll in the NSSF medical branch. The fee for the year is 30% of the legal minimum salary (203,000 L.L.).

### VI. Student Activities

A fee of 422,000 L.L. is charged every semester to cover student activities.

### VII. Internet Fee

A fee of 83,000 L.L. is charged every semester to cover student internet services.

### VIII. Graduation Fees

Graduation fees of 900,000 L.L. (220,000 L.L. for TD graduates) are charged to every graduating student upon submitting the clearance form.

If a duly registered student withdraws for justifiable reasons, the following refund schedule will be applied:

<b>Before the official beginning of classes</b>	75% of tuition
<b>During the first week of classes</b>	50% of tuition
<b>During the second week of classes</b>	25% of tuition
