

UNDERGRADUATE ADMISSION

GENERAL

Document required for admission decision

- A recent passport size photograph taken within the past 6 months.
- A photocopy of your identity card (For Lebanese Applicants) or passport.
- School Grades and Recommendation of Grade 10 and 11 in a sealed and stamped envelope mailed to the University or emailed by the school to admissions@balamand.edu.lb
- SAT scores (if applicable)
- English/French proficiency test: TOEFL/IELTS/ SAT writing and language test/CES/Duolingo (if applicable).

An application fee (50\$)/or other fees for the placement tests depending on your choice of major.

Document required for enrollment

- A certified official secondary school certificate (when received). Non-Lebanese Baccalaureate students should submit the equivalence of the sophomore credential from the equivalence committee at the Lebanese Ministry of Education.
- Evidence of having successfully completed grade 12.

FRESHMAN APPLICANTS

In addition to the general requirements, applicants to Freshman class should provide:

- High School Diploma
- Permission to join the Freshman Program from the Lebanese Ministry of Education and Higher Education
- SAT or ACT results prior to admission as follow:

GRADUATE ADMISSION

ADMISSION INFORMATION

Admission to the graduate programs is granted through the Office of Admissions. The Office of Admissions receives and processes all applications, evaluates credentials and issues notification letters.

Standards under which applicants are admitted for study in these programs are established and monitored by the departments and Faculties concerned. Acceptance into the graduate program is based on the candidate meeting University admission requirements and the recommendation of the Faculty Graduate Admission Committee.

CONDITIONAL ADMISSION FOR ALL FACULTIES EXCEPT THE FACULTY OF ENGINEERING

An applicant may be accepted conditionally, if he/she has an undergraduate cumulative average ≥ 77 or its equivalent as evaluated by the Department the applicant wishes to join.

FACULTY OF ENGINEERING

Bachelor of Science (B.S.) applicants with cumulative average of 78 but less than 80/100 can be admitted into the Master of Science (M.S.) program on probation and who have 80/100 and above can be admitted on clear standing.

REGISTRATION LOAD

Full-time students must enroll in at least 9 credit hours per semester and a maximum of 12 credit hours. (See appropriate Faculty regulations).

TRANSFER CREDITS

Students transferring to the graduate programs may be granted transfer credits up to 40% of the total credits required of the degree. Transferred credits apply only to courses in which the applicant maintain an average ≥ 80 and equivalent in content to courses offered at UOB.

The concerned Department/Faculty decides on the equivalency of courses.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- A certified copy of diploma and two recommendation letters
- A diploma equivalence from the Lebanese Ministry of Education and Higher Education (if applicable)
- An official transcript with course description of all completed courses

An application fee of 60 USD and/or other fees for the placement tests depending on the major of choice

EARLY ADMISSION

Applicants should submit their application prior to the deadlines mentioned above, SAT results will be considered up to December 2024 session.

Note that Admission is conditional upon receiving the applicants Lebanese Baccalaureate or its equivalence from the Lebanese Ministry of Education and Higher Education. Applicants who are not granted early admission will be placed in the pool with regular admission applicants.

Applicants may not register until all conditions are met.

ADMISSION EXAMINATIONS

SCHOLASTIC APTITUDE TEST (SAT)

SAT is a requirement for all undergraduate applicants except:

- Applicants to non-scientific disciplines at the Faculty of Arts and Sciences
- Applicants to Académie Libanaise des Beaux-Art
- Applicants to majors taught in French
- Applicants to Tourism and Hotel Management
- Transfer students from other Universities (who completed successfully one year or have 20 transferable credits)

Students should contact the nearest AMIDEAST testing center for more details related to the SAT.

When registering for the SAT, applicants to the University of Balamand should enter the UOB code: 2960, and request from the Educational Testing Service to send the scores directly to the Office of Admissions.

LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY REQUIREMENTS

Prior to registering at the University of Balamand, students must demonstrate a level of English or French language proficiency consistent with the requirements of their study program.

FRENCH LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

Undergraduate and graduate applicants must pass the French Entrance Exam (Test de Positionnement)

- Undergraduate and graduate applicants holding DELF/DALF with a degree level B2 (scoring at least 50/100 and 15/25 on the writing component (production écrit)) or C1, will be placed as FREN201.
- Applicants holding a DELF/DALF with a degree level B1 scoring above 70 will be placed as FREN101 but they must complete successfully FREN101 within the first semester of enrollment at the University.

INTENSIVE ENGLISH PROGRAM

The intensive English Program is intended for applicants who have been selected for admission but have not met the English Language Proficiency Requirement.

The program consists of three levels: ENGL002S, ENGL002 and ENGL003. Students enrolled in ENGL002 are entitled to register only one SOP course (00-Level course).

Students enrolled in ENGL003 may take only one course and its lab toward a degree while working towards achieving the level of English needed for carrying a full load in the regular program.

SPECIAL ORIENTATION PROGRAM (SOP)

The Special Orientation Program is designed to prepare applicants who had their secondary education outside Lebanon and those who have obtained the appropriate Technical Baccalaureate for the major of choice. Applications are studied case by case.

FINANCIAL SUPPORT FOR UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMS

ATHLETIC SCHOLARSHIPS

The University of Balamand offers Athletic Scholarships for students who are eligible to be varsity team members. The main objective of the Athletic Scholarship is to provide talented students, who play sports, the opportunity to study at UOB and compete in university sports. Students should be enrolled on a full-time basis, maintain a cumulative average ≥ 75 with a clear academic status and have applied for Financial Aid. The Selection Committee determines the amount of needed scholarships per academic year according to approved budget by the University Administration, this percentage may vary between 10% - 20% coverage of the tuition fees taking into consideration that no student is allowed more than 70% of total financial support.

Undergraduate students majoring in Nursing, Public Health and Development Sciences or Health Promotion will receive additional 20% to be allocated by submitting the financial aid application.

Faculty support recipients should maintain a Semester Average ≥ 75 with a clear academic status (Cumulative Average ≥ 75) in order to retain the scholarship in subsequent semester.

Scholarship Criteria for Chemistry, Environmental Sciences and Mathematics:

- 50% scholarship for the top 5 students with a General Average of >80, evaluated at the end of each semester (overall average, not semester average).
- 30% scholarship for the next top 10 students with a General Average of >75, evaluated at the end of each semester (overall average, not semester average).
- The remaining students will receive standard financial aid.
- Points 1 and 2 will apply after the completion of the first semester at UOB.

FINANCIAL AID

Undergraduate students may benefit from financial aid support covering 10% to 40% of their tuition fees. Financial Aid is awarded on the basis of need first and academic performance second.

To be eligible for Financial Aid, an undergraduate student should be:

- Enrolled on a full-time basis. An undergraduate student is considered a full-time student if registered 12 credits and above during the Fall and Spring semester, 6 credits during the Summer semester of an Academic Year.
- Demonstrate financial need.
- Maintain a cumulative average ≥ 70 with a clear academic standing.

Application Process

Newly applying students to UOB or continuing UOB students should submit a Financial Aid application filled by the applicant and his/her parents along with the required documents. Applications should be submitted before the end of June.

STUDENT WORK

Financial Aid recipients are eligible to apply for the student work support. Applicants may receive additional Financial Aid in the form of work study. Student work can cover from 5% to 20% of the tuition fees.

FINANCIAL SUPPORT FOR GRADUATE PROGRAMS

GRADUATE ASSISTANTSHIP

Graduate Assistantship Program aims in advancing graduate studies by attracting academically good students who are expected to support the UOB academic mission and research. These assistantships may cover from 20% to 50% of the tuition fees. Selected students are allocated up to 20 hours per week (for a 50% Assistantship). Applications to this Program are submitted through respective Faculties and reviewed prior to the start of each semester.

FACULTY OF MEDICINE

Faculty of Medicine students can apply for financial aid support.

FINANCIAL SUPPORT FOR ALL PROGRAMS

SIBLING GRANT

Siblings enrolled at UOB during the same period are entitled to a fee reduction provided that they are enrolled on a full time basis and maintaining a cumulative Average ≥ 75 with a clear academic standing. Deduction from tuition fees will be granted as follow:

- 2nd Sibling: 7.5% - 3rd Sibling: 12.5%

No application is needed to qualify to this grant.

DEFERRED PAYMENT

Deferred payment is handled during the registration process through the Comptrollers' Office (Monthly installments with 0% interest).

AGREEMENT

Students benefiting from any agreement must apply for Financial aid each academic year and submit all required documents.

To be eligible for support, a student:

- Must be enrolled at UOB on a full-time basis.
- Must be in good academic standing, demonstrating satisfactory academic performance as per the required cumulative average.
- A percentage will be allocated for non-intensive and non-repeated courses.
